## Bunker Hill wins first title; National Trail racers score three

The 2002 North Central Division NHRA Summit Racing Series Finals, held Sept. 13-15 at Indianapolis Raceway Park, was dedicated in memory of the late Mary Hullinger, co-owner of Bunker Hill Dragstrip from 1956 to 1996, during the pre-race ceremony Saturday afternoon. The Bunker Hill team then went on to score its first team championship in the 26-year history of the event with an overall strong team showing to hold off solid individual performances by National Trail Raceway.

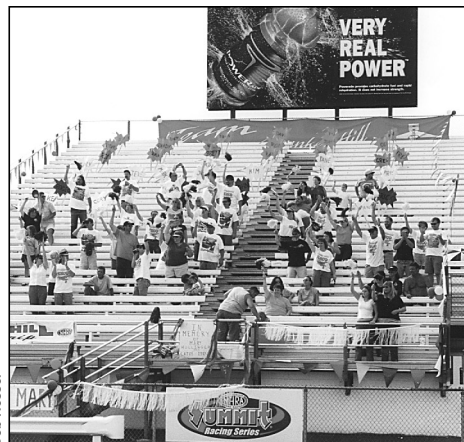
While divine intervention may have played a role in Bunker Hill's team success, the group also garnered the *National DRAGSTER* Team Spirit award.

National Trail Raceway advanced an unprecedented three individual champions to the NHRA Summit Racing Series National Championship, to be held in Pomona Nov. 7-10 during the Automobile Club of Southern California NHRA Finals. Bob Biser wheeled his '78 Pontiac Firebird to the Super Pro title by defeating Les Belle of Springfield, Ont., representing St.

Thomas Dragway. The Super Pro Bike final was all National Trail: Burt Exman rode his Suzuki to the win over Bruce Sauer. In Sportsman, Terry McGee captured his first division championship in his '74 Duster with a final-round defeat of Mike Davis and his '66 Mustang, representing Gateway Int'l Raceway.

Jack Spirey of Edgewater Sports Park will head to Pomona after scoring the Pro win with his '72 Maverick over Kil-Kare's Doug Caplinger and his '72 Chevelle.

The weekend was packed full of racing. Track champions met in the VP Racing Fuels Race of Champions presented by CPM Racing Fuels Friday afternoon. Bunker Hill's Randy Wolfe edged out Scott Rienschild of National Trail for the Super Pro title. Troy Bogner of Route 66 Raceway scored the Pro win over Terry Willard of Coles County Dragway. Route 66 also had the winner in Super Pro Bike; Tom Florey defeated Bill Bottoms. For the Sportsman crown, Deanna McGee took a double-breakout final.
